4. Jonathan Maas – The honors program enhances the reputation of De Anza College. De Anza will definitely suffer without the honors program since it will decrease the enthusiasm of students and teachers.
5. Lucero Cesena - I am a PUENTE student and would like to tell everyone here that the program is very helpful to students. It helped me improve my English skills that lead to an increased self confidence. I request you to allocate more money to PUENTE.
6. Jennifer – I am here to voice my concern on all programs that didn't receive any funding. Honors program was cut because some people said that students were not getting much from it. We are really concerned about the honors program,
7. Faye Rachford – There are plenty of budget issues and ramifications that should be looked at. There are clubs that have not been represented at all. I think that you should be able to question authority. It is not something that should be taken lightly.
