

Resolution on Cross Listing

Whereas, cross-listing is a matter of curriculum, and, as such, is an area of primary reliance under the purview of the Academic Senate, per Education Code section 70902 (b) (7) and Title 5 section 53200,

Therefore, be it resolved that the Academic Senate expects that the administration cease efforts or directives to UN-cross-list courses; and faculty who have been asked to un-cross list courses be given the opportunity to re-instate cross-listing through a method to be determined by the academic senate; and forms be made available through the Curriculum Committee website so that faculty are able to cross-list courses, including the official Curriculum Committee forms (Cover Sheet, etc.) to have the cross-listing options re-established to the appearance of the forms last year in Winter 2015 (e.g., on p. 1 and p. 3 of the Cover Sheet), and on any other relevant forms, with the forms to be made available by the end of Winter 2016.
