- **Qualifications**
 - De Anza student
 - 18 units completed at De Anza

Application questions for students that are applying themselves

Please answer yes or no:

Are you experiencing housing insecurity?

- Are you experiencing food insecurity?
- Are you or have you been involved in the criminal justice system or been systems impacted?
- Are you balancing school with a full-time job and/or parenting, childcare, or caregiving responsibilities?
- Are you or your parents undocumented?
- Do you have the ability to work in the US?
- Are you unable to be a full-time student because of circumstances out of your control?

Required Question:

How will this money help you be successful at De Anza?

Application Questions for faculty/staff nominations

Short answer questions. You are required to answer all of them.

- What are the student's future educational plans (at De Anza or another college?)
- Is the student on academic probation and, if so, what is their academic plan to get back into good standing?
- How would this scholarship help the student stay in school and achieve their goals?

- Is there anything else you wish to share?

Award amount: up to \$1,000

Number of recipients: 2 @ \$1,000 for student applications, and 3 @ \$500 that are staff/faculty nominations

Deadline to apply: April 30, 2023

Date to open applications: March 1, 2023?
